



Tioga County is updating the County's Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP). A Hazard Mitigation Plan is a way to identify natural hazards the County faces, evaluate people and property at risk, and create strategies to minimize damages in the long term.

Tioga County's current Hazard Mitigation Plan was created in 2018 and will expire on August 12, 2024. The updated plan will incorporate the new guidelines provided by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and New York State's Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services (DHSES). Furthermore, it will allow the County to remain eligible for future mitigation funding including the Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) grant Program.

Your input is essential for making sure the plan reflects public priorities. Your answers to this survey will help the County understand how these natural hazards impact the public and how the County can help reduce this impact.
