



SIDEWALK COMMITTEE

May 20, 2015

R. Stevens called meeting to order 7:02 PM. No meetings since 1/21/15.

R. Stevens said he understood timeline change from 2015 to Spring 2016.

R. Jacobs presented information:

- ❖ ROW services cannot be done in-house; will be done through DELTA rep as they have no influence or interest, and will not slant any presentations. Conference call on May 21, 2015.
- ❖ \$202,000 total construction; \$100,000 would be cost for one side (WEST, school side) and \$100,000 design; + incidentals.
- ❖ For temporary easements (TE), appraisal will be done by ROW service; easement to go on property to remove old sidewalk, which is in ROW. Market value for temporary use of property for removal of sidewalk. The TEs filed with County.
- ❖ DELTA will determine what needs replacing
- ❖ ROW costs (\$50,000) not submitted in the original budget
- ❖ Later on, will only need construction costs for the EAST side
- ❖ State ADA compliant needs 5' wide turnaround at 200'; as long as there are passing zones, including driveways, every 200' or less, no turnaround needed

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SUMMARY:

- \$212,000 grant award
- \$265,000 total grant, minus \$115,000 ROW, minus \$100,000 construction; \$10-20,000 inspection (9% of project); and the temporary easements \$20,000 ish (9% of \$100,000).
- One –half of Whig to be done, EAST (school side)
- Contract includes ROW (T.E) and design for BOTH SIDES; so Village will have the information for second side in future as one side will be completed Spring 2016
- DOT wants DELTA for the design
